



QUALITY, ENVIRONMENTAL, HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

Our foremost objective is to satisfy Clients with a high quality engineering service capable of designing, building and maintaining product and service that will consistently meet their quality, safety, environmental and reliability needs. We aim to achieve those needs in a safe, responsible, sustainable and environmentally sound way, in accordance with our QHSE and Ethical policies, procedures and the company's strategic direction. Quality, Health, Safety and the Environment are considered to be of paramount importance. Orbital will actively promote and administer a strong Quality, Health, Safety, Environmental and Ethical culture amongst our staff and our sub-contractors.

To assure these objectives are realized, we have established an Integrated Management System incorporating the requirements of the current revisions of ISO9001 & ISO/TS29001 for Quality Management (see also last paragraph), ISO14001 for Environmental Management, and OHSAS18001 for Health & Safety Management. The scope of the QHSE management system covers: Design, build, installation, commissioning and after sales service of process systems for analysis, control and environmental purposes.

The Management Team are committed to the leadership, implementation, development and continuous improvement of the Management Systems, Policies, work practices, procedures and competencies to meet the developing needs of our clients, regulatory, statutory and other requirements, including the aim to enhance customer satisfaction.

The Management Team will adopt a risk-based strategy to identify, assess and raise awareness of business, environmental and health & safety risks and opportunities; implementing processes and procedures to prevent and mitigate negative risks whilst pursuing positive risk opportunities.

The Company will assure the health, safety, and welfare of employees whilst at work in accordance with the Health & Safety at Work act 1974. The combined operation of the Management Systems is recognised as key for achieving this. Procedures and practices are also designed to protect the environment and health & safety and improve our performance, reducing environmental impact, prevent pollution and increase sustainability. We are also committed to complying with our health and safety and environmental obligations as required by statutory regulations and where required by legislation, including our activities and operations requiring registration with second & third party environmental organisations.

The communication of the Management Teams commitment to the management system is via this policy statement, publication of Company Policy, procedures, work instructions, and day to day communications. All employees are encouraged to participate in the development of the management systems, environmental processes and safe systems of work including any relevant improvement projects.

Company policies, objectives and targets are established and reviewed during annual 'Management Review', upon establishment of the significant environmental impacts, health and safety and environmental initiatives. Objectives and obligations can also be established via legislation changes, periodically by Management directives and meetings, and for specific project works.

Information, training, equipment and supervision will be provided to employees according to task and business needs, in order to perform their duties competently and safely. All personnel shall work with consideration for their own safety and the environment, and others who may be affected by their acts or omissions. All personnel shall work in agreed ways to prevent pollution and reduce environmental impacts.

It is the responsibility of management and employees to understand and apply this policy, associated procedures, practices and project/product specific documentation in all aspects of their responsibility areas and continue to maintain our high standards and reputation. This policy and associated procedures are monitored by internal and external audit and inspection.

A copy of this Policy is displayed in reception and is available to other interested parties, and is communicated to employees and persons working on our behalf. Orbital's Product Division is not included within the overall scope of the Quality element of this policy. The Product Division has a separate Quality Policy to reflect the different Quality Management System standard requirements that they have to meet.

As President I have overall responsibility for this policy and have allocated all necessary resources for its implementation and ongoing compliance.
